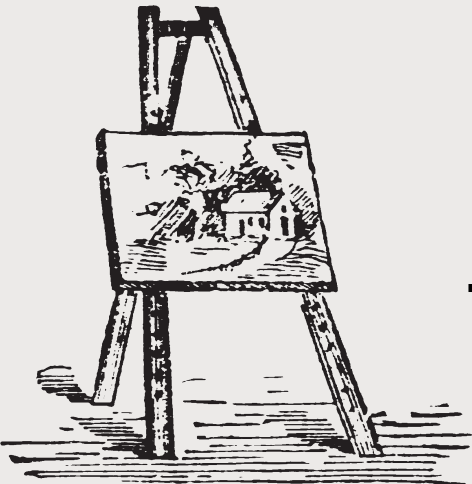
High School Drama Club

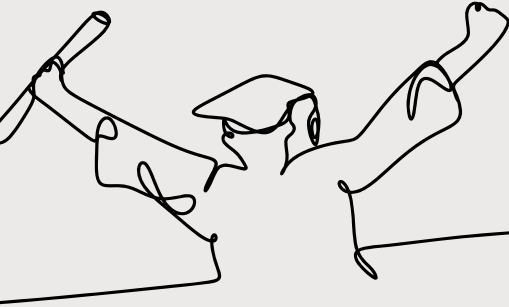


Art Club

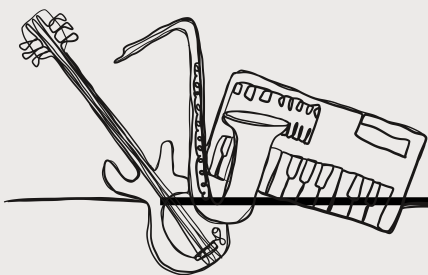
Band and Choir

The Drama Club have been preparing their production of, "Peter Pan." Be sure to come out and watch!



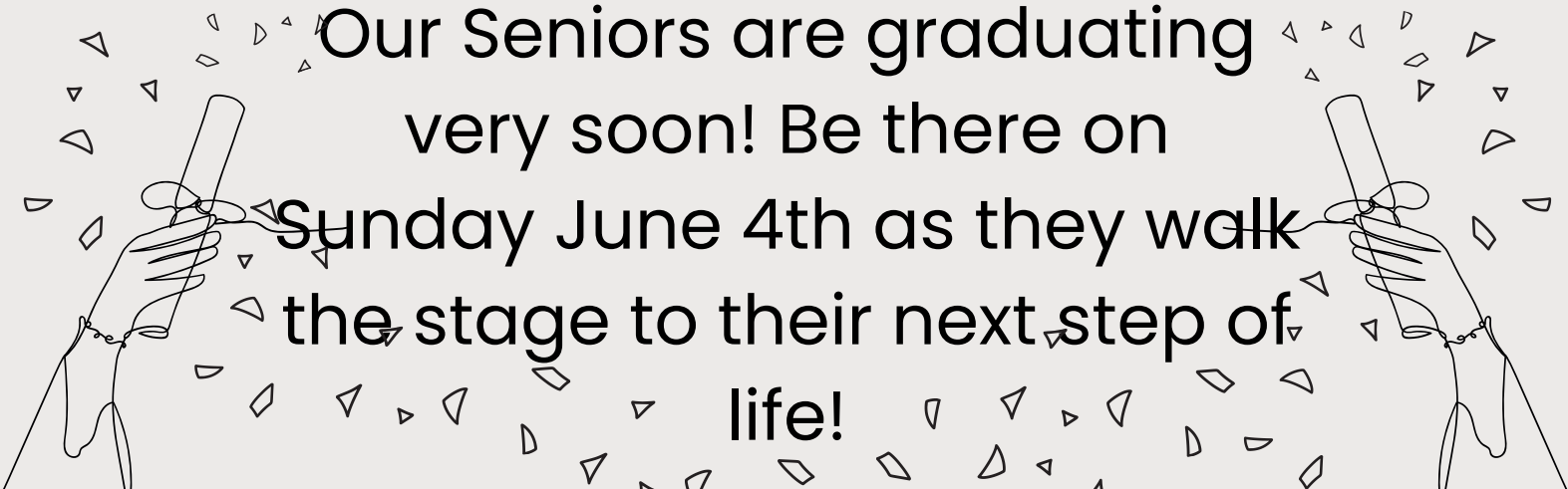
