

## AT HOME HEALTH SCREENING PROTOCOL

In an effort to maintain a healthy learning environment for our students and staff, Elwood Community School Corporation is asking our families to conduct an at home health screening before sending children to school or any school-related event. This screening protocol is a precautionary measure to try and lessen the amount of sick-potentially sick children coming into our school buildings each day so that we can continue to provide essential educational services to our families and community.

Please answer the following questions honestly for each child in your home, and do not send children to school if there are *any* YES responses. It is important for the sake of all individuals in the school community to reduce the risk of exposure to COVID-19, influenza or other serious medical outbreaks that are easily spread.

If the student has knowingly been exposed to COVID-19 or has any of the symptoms below, please do not send them to school or any school-related event until have been medically cleared to attend.

## SYMPTOMS

New onset of severe headache,
especially with a fever
Chills, muscle pain, body aches, or fatigue
A fever of 100 degrees or greater
New uncontrolled cough or shortness
of breath
Sore throat
Loss of taste or smell
Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain
